Breast Cancer Support Fund

BCSF exists to bridge the gap between the financial reality faced by breast cancer patients and the limited financial assistance available. We have provided more than \$400,000 in short-term financial assistance to more than 270 breast cancer patients in need while undergoing treatment.

Why We Exist

Our mission is to support breast cancer patients on their journey to wellness by providing short-term financial support.



- **76%** of women that BCSF helps live on less than \$25,000 per year while they are in treatment
- **48%** of the patients are younger than 50 years of age
- **33%** of the women we support have children under the age of 18
- **16%** of the women we support are living with Stage IV metastatic breast cancer

Who We Help

We support a wide spectrum of women – young mothers, single mothers, working women, widows, single women, and the self-employed; women living on social assistance and disability pensions, women in the earliest stages of breast cancer and women diagnosed with Stage IV metastatic breast cancer.





33% of the patients we support have children under the age of 18 and **40%** are single moms.
